

Membership Appeals

Removal or suspension of membership

Any party whose membership is removed or suspended shall be entitled to appeal in writing to the Trade Association Manager at the Registered Office of the Association within fourteen days of notification of the suspension or expulsion, stating in full the grounds for their appeal and providing documents in support. The expulsion or suspension shall be suspended pending the outcome of the appeal. Appeals shall be heard as soon as reasonably possible thereafter by a duly convened meeting of the Council of Management at which the member may personally attend to state their case. The decision by a simple majority vote of the Council of Management shall be final.

Refusal of membership application

Any party who application is declined or refused shall be entitled to appeal in writing to the Trade Association Manager at the Registered Office of the Association within fourteen days of notification of the refusal, stating in full the grounds for their appeal and providing all documents in support. Appeals shall be heard as soon as reasonably possible thereafter by a duly convened meeting of the Council of Management at which the member may personally attend to state their case. The decision by a simple majority vote of the Council of Management shall be final.
