

**ATLAS' 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Photography Competition**  
**Guidance, Terms and Conditions for Members and Photographers**

**YOU COULD WIN £200.00!**



During our 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary year we will be selecting **four** of the best photographs of all our work activities. A selection panel will judge the entries based on the guidance given below and your, and your employer's, names will be given credit to any picture published.

- The competition is open to ATLAS members and their employees only.
  - The competition is free to enter.
  - The judging panel's decision is final and no negotiation will be entered into with respect to any such decision.
  - The judges are seeking a range of images to reflect the diversity of skills across ATLAS membership. Photos of unusual access jobs and structures are particularly welcome.
  - There is no limit to the number of images a photographer/member can submit.
  - The content must be technically correct and compliant with all regulations and guidance issued by, for example, HSE, CONIAC, NASC, IRATA and ATLAS.
  - Where photographs are of unfinished work (e.g. scaffolding or rigging) the activity should be based on the 'installing activity' and appropriate PPE worn. Non-technically compliant temporary or uncompleted access-ways or platforms should be avoided.
  - The operative(s) carrying out the work should be dressed, where possible, in matching compliant PPE and if wearing face masks, goggles or harnesses with correct lanyard etc. – properly fitted and worn.
  - The frame of the picture should avoid views of sensitive locations, processes or site security arrangements and client approval should be sought as appropriate.
  - Often a posed activity can demonstrate the work process well, but on occasion a bit of dust creates a good 'person-at-work image.'
  - Discreet company logos are acceptable. ATLAS reserves the right to anonymise overt logos to reflect neutrality towards membership.
  - Any images submitted to ATLAS for this competition and used for publicity purposes will require a letter of declaration granting copyright permission. The wording of the declaration will be provided by ATLAS at the appropriate time.
  - Images can be taken from any timeframe i.e. historic photos are welcome.
  - By submitting images to the competition, you confirm:
    - You are happy for ATLAS to use these in promotional videos and materials
    - You are happy for the photographer's name, and the name of your company, to be shared publicly
    - You are the sole owner of each image
    - You have permission of any persons pictured to submit their image
    - No-one under the age of 18 is included in the photographs.
  - ATLAS reserves the right to re-enter unsuccessful images in the following quarter's competition.
  - Images should be submitted to [Megan Gee](#) no later than the following closing dates:
    - **Sunday 28 February 2021**
    - **Monday 31 May 2021**
    - **Tuesday 31 August 2021**
    - **Tuesday 30 November 2021.**
- The submission must include the name of the photographer.
- Winners will be announced in the following month's newsletter.
  - A prize of £200.00 per winning image will be issued to the photographer (not the member company) by bank transfer.
